Program Details:

- Groups may volunteer year round, weather permitting. The Zoo's greatest need for volunteers is between February and November.
- A maximum of 50 volunteers will be accepted on any given day. Groups will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Time requirement is a minimum of 4 hours.
- Must be 18 years or older. Children may not accompany adults while volunteering.
- Each participant must sign a waiver of liability.
